- 01/19 Holy Prophet Joel. Translation of the holy relics of St. John the Wonderworker of Rila. Martyr Varus of Egypt (+304). St. John the Wonderworker of Kronstadt (+1908).
- 02/20 Great Martyr Artemius of Alexandria (+361). St. Gerasimus, the New Ascetic & Wonderworker, of Cephalonia (+1570).
- 03/21 St. Hilarion the Great of Palestine (+372). Translation of the holy relics of St. Christodulos of Patmos.

- **04/22** *Sixth Sunday of Luke.* Synaxis of  $M\Theta$  Icon of Kazan. St. Abercius the Wonderworker, Bishop of Hieropolis & Equal to the Holy Apostles (+ca. 167).
- 05/23 Holy Apostle James, the Brother of God, First Bishop of Jerusalem (+ca. 62). St. Ignatius, Patriarch of Con/nople (+877).
- 06/24 Synaxis of M⊕ Icon called "Joy of All that Sorrow". Great Martyr Al-Harith (Arethas) & his 4299 fellow Martyrs in Najran of Arabia Felix (+524).
- 07/25 Martyrs & Notaries Marcian the Reader & Martyrius the Subdeacon of Con/nople (+346), disciples of St. Paul the Confessor.
- 08/26 Great & Glorious Martyr Demetrius, the Wonderworker & Myrrhstreamer of Thessalonica (+290).

- 09/27 St. Prokla, wife of Pontius Pilate. Martyr Nestor of Thessalonica (+290).
- 10/28 The commemoration of the revealing of the Holy incorrupt relics of our Blessed St. Philaret, Metropolitan of New York, the New Confessor. St. Arsenios, the Healer of Cappadocia (+1924).

- **11/29** Seventh Sunday of Luke. Righteous Martyr Anastasia of Rome (+256). St. Abramius of Mesopotamia (+366) & his niece Mary (+371).
- 12/30 Martyr Zenobius, Bishop of Aegea in Cilicia, & his sister in the flesh Zenobia (+ca. 290). St. Joseph I, Patriarch of Con/nople (+1283)
- 13/31 Holy Apostles of the 70: Stachys; Apelles; Amplias; Urban; Narcissus & Aristobulus. Holy 100,000 Martyrs of Tbilisi (+1227).

- 20/07 Holy 33 Martyrs of Melitene (+290). St. Lazarus, the Wonderworker & Stylite of Mt. Galesion (+1053). New Hieromartyrs Cyril, Metropolitan of Kazan & Joseph, Metropolitan of Petrograd who were slain by the atheists (+1937).
- 21/08 Synaxis of the Holy Archangels Michael, Gabriel, & Raphael, & all of the other Bodiless Powers. Repose of St. Philaret, Metropolitan of New York, the New Confessor, (+1985).
  - 22/09 St. Symeon Metaphrates of Con/nople (+10th C). St. Nectarius, the Wonderworker of Aegina, Metropolitan of Pentapolis in Egypt (+1920).

- 29/16 Holy Apostle & Evangelist Matthew.
  - 30/17 St. Gregory the Wonderworker, Bishop of Neocaesarea (+266).
