- 01/18 St. John, disciple of St. Gregory of Decapolis (+ca. 820). Righteous Mother Athanasia the Wonderworker of Aegina (+9th C).
-  02/19 St. Symeon, Abbot of Philotheou Monastery on Mount Athos (+1594). New Righteous Martyr Agathangelus of Esphigmenou Monastery on Mt. Athos (+1819).
- 03/20 Holy Apostle Zacchaeus, the former Chief Publican of Jericho & First Bishop of Caesarea in Palestine. St. Theodore of the Hair-shirt of Con/nople (+late 4th - early 5th C).
-  04/21 Empress Alexandra of Nicomedia who was martyred after believing in Christ through St. George (+296). Hieromartyr Januarius Bishop of Benevento & companions in Campania (+305).
- 05/22 Holy Apostle Nathanael. St. Theodore of Sykeon, Bishop of Anastasiopolis (+613).

- 06/23 **Fourth Sunday of Pascha: Sunday of the Paralytic.** The Holy Great Martyr George the Trophy-bearer who was beheaded in Nicomedia (+296).
- 07/24 Righteous Mother Elizabeth the Wonderworker of Con/nople (+540).

- 08/25 Holy Apostle & Evangelist Mark (+63). St. Macedonius, Patriarch of Con/nople (+516).
-  09/26 **MID-PENTECOST** St. Glaphyra & Hieromartyr Basileus, Bishop of Amasia (+322). St. Stephen the First Bishop & Enlightener of Perm (+1396).
- 10/27 Hieromartyr Symeon, Bishop of Jerusalem & Kinsman of our Lord (+107).
-  11/28 Holy Nine Martyrs of Cyzicus: Theognis; Rufis; Antipater; Theostichus; Artemas; Magnus; Theodotus; Thaumasius; & Philemon (+4th C).
- 12/29 Holy Apostles of the 70, Jason & Sosipater.

- 13/30 **Fifth Sunday of Pascha: Sunday of the Samaritan Woman.** Holy Apostle James (+1st C), brother in the flesh of the Holy Apostle John the Theologian.
- 14/01 Prophet Jeremias (+4th C BC). Synaxis of the Three New Martyrs of Mt. Athos: Euthymius; Ignatius; & Acacius. St. Tamara, Queen of Georgia (+1213).
- 15/02 Translation of the holy relics of St. Athanasius the Great, Archbishop of Alexandria.
-  16/03 **Apodosis of Mid-Pentecost.** Our Righteous Father Theodosius, Abbot of the Kiev Caves Larva (+1074).
- 17/04 Virgin Martyr Pelagia of Tarsus (+287).
-  18/05 Great Virgin Martyr Irene who ended her life in Ephesus (+4th C).
- 19/06 Just & much-suffering Holy Prophet Job. Righteous & God-bearing Father Seraphim of Mt. Domvu in Levadia (+1602).

- 20/07 **Sixth Sunday of Pascha: Sunday of the Blind Man.** Synaxis of Zhirovitsy Icon of MΘ. Commemoration of the Sign of the Cross that appeared for many hours over Jerusalem in the year 351 AD. St. John Zedazeni of Georgia (+6th C) & his twelve disciples.
- 21/08 Icon of MΘ of Cassiopeia whose Holy gift of new eyes to the unjustly-blinded Stephen in the year 1530 we celebrate. Synaxis of the Manna from the grave of the Holy Apostle John the Theologian. St. Arsenius the Great of Scete (+449).
- 22/09 Holy & Glorious Prophet Esaias (Isaiah) (+ca. 681 BC). Righteous Father Shio of Mghvime in Georgia (+7th C).
-  23/10 **Apodosis of Holy Pascha.** [IN SOME USAGES, A FAST-FREE DAY IS PERMITTED]
- 24/11 ✠ **ASCENSION OF OUR LORD, GOD & SAVIOUR JESUS CHRIST.** ✠
-  25/12 Ss. Epiphanius, Bishop of Constantia in Cyprus (+ca. 403) & Germanus, Archbishop of Con/nople (+ca. 740).
- 26/13 Virgin Martyr Glyceria of Trajanopolis in Thrace (+141). Righteous Father Euthymius the New, Founder of the Iveron Monastery (+1028).

- 27/14 **Seventh Sunday of Pascha: Sunday of the 318 Holy Fathers of the First Ecumenical Council in the year 325 in Nicaea.**
- 28/15 Righteous Father Pachomius the Great of Egypt (+346). Holy Crown Prince Demetrius of Moscow & all Russia, the Wonderworker (+1591).
- 29/16 Righteous Father Theodore the Sanctified of Egypt (+368). Holy Martyred Bishops Abdas & Abdiesus, & the 38 with them in Persia (+ca. 375).
-  30/17 Holy Apostle Andronicus of the 70 with his companion Junia (+58).
- 31/18 Holy, glorious & great Sovereigns of the Roman Empire Constantine (+337) & his mother Helen (+ca. 330) of Con/nople, the Equal to the Apostles [Transferred from May 21 / June 3 due to the feast of Holy Pentecost].
